Elder Charles A. Didier is an emeritus member of the First Quorum of the Seventy of The LDS Church. A native French speaker, Didier was the first European resident to have been called as a general authority in the history of the church. Didier was born in Brussels, Belgium. At age 22, Didier was baptized a member of the LDS Church. Prior to his call as a general authority, Didier was the president of the France–Switzerland Mission of the church and a regional representative for the Twelve Apostles. In October 1975, was called to be a member of First Quorum of the Seventy. In 1992, Elder Didier became one of the seven presidents of the Seventy. In 2007, Elder Didier was assigned as president of the newly consolidated Brazil Area of the church. In 2009 he was made General Authority Emeritus. Didier is married to Lucie Lodomez; the couple has two children.
