Since 1978 Professor Lynn Wardle has taught at the Brigham Young University Law School. His major areas of teaching and scholarship are Family Law, Conflict of Laws, Biomedical Ethics & Law, and Origins of the U.S. Constitution. He also has lectured at law schools or presented in academic or professional conferences in more than 20 nations.

Lynn served as President (2000-2002) and Secretary-General (1994-2000) of the International Society of Family Law (ISFL), and still serves on the ISFL Executive Council.

Lynn is editor of *What's the Harm? Does Legalizing Same-Sex Marriage Really Hurt Individuals, Families or Society?* (forthcoming Fall 2008, University Press of America). Lynn advised the drafters of the federal Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA), and testified before both the U.S. House and Senate Committees that passed DOMA. He also has testified before several state legislative committees about state DOMAS, and has participated in debates or made presentations about same-sex marriage and adoption at more than twenty American law schools.

Professor Wardle graduated from Brigham Young University (1971) and Duke University School of Law (1974). He and his wife, Marian, have two sons, two daughters-in-law, and five grandchildren.
