All of the above positions participate on a monthly SCB call and at least one or two other monthly committee or team calls. SCB members are expected to attend the Fall Leadership Conference at Aspen Grove outside Provo, Utah September 29-30, 2016. Some travel reimbursement is usually available for this meeting. They also are expected to attend the Society's annual conference, which will be on February 16-18, 2017. There is usually little or no travel reimbursement for this meeting. Thus SCB members are encouraged to seek funding from their schools for such travel.

**A SCB Committee Representative:**

- Serves as the student representative on a Law Society committee
- Participates regularly in committee conference calls
- Supports the committee by fulfilling assignments and proposing initiatives
- Reports regularly to the SCB

**A SCB Area Representative:**

- Serves as the primary liaison between student chapters in their Area and (1) the Area Leadership Team and (2) the SCB
- Works with the Area Leadership Team to help the Society grow and develop in their Area, which means working with both student and attorney chapters
- Helps existing chapters succeed and identify potential new chapters for creation
- Works closely with student chapter presidents in their Area by making sure they have information, are organized and functioning, and by communicating and seeking to resolve chapter needs with the SCB and the Area Leadership Teams
- Works to revive dormant student chapters
- Reports regularly to the SCB

**A SCB Regional Vice-Chair:**

- Oversees student chapters in one of four regions
- Works with an attorney regional vice chair on the Chapter Relations Council who oversees the Area Leadership Teams in one of the four regions in the Society
- Assists the SCB Chair in running the SCB

**The SCB Chair:**

- Is the primary student leader in the Law Society
- Chairs and conducts the business of the SCB
- Works with the Chapter Relations Council Chair who supervises chapter oversight structure
- Coordinates with other attorney committee chairs
- Is responsible for the growth and development of student chapters in the Society

Prior JRCLS leadership experience is not necessary to serve on the SCB and rising 2Ls are encouraged to apply.
