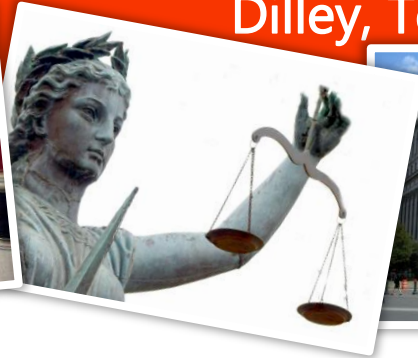
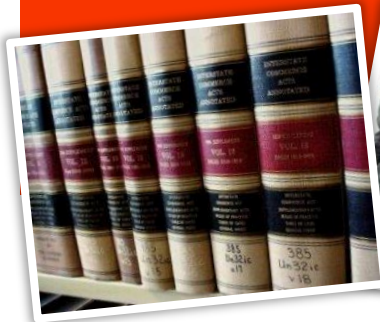


JRCLS Pro Bono Project

The JRCLS Women in Law Committee is teaming up with the Dilley Pro Bono Project & CARA (Catholic Legal Immigration Network, American Immigration Council, Refugee & Immigrant Center for Education & Legal Services and American Immigration Lawyers Assoc.) to provide pro bono legal services to women and children currently housed in the South Texas Family Residential Facility. Space has been reserved for 15 lawyers to join in helping at the facility. Spanish speakers are preferred, but not necessary.

We will begin our week at a mandatory orientation on the evening of Sunday, November 4. We will then report to the facility Monday morning and provide support for 14-18 hours per day through Friday. Volunteers must commit for the entire week. The facility is located approximately 80 miles from San Antonio and currently houses approximately 1,000 mothers and children. This will be a life-changing experience that is sure to be rewarding.
