

## **Ten Suggestions for Pro Bono/Volunteer Service Projects**

1. Volunteer to teach local students or other community groups about:
  - U.S. Constitution
  - Respect & importance of rule of law
  - U.S. legal system
  - Civics/importance of being involved in one's community
2. Organize through local church leaders or other community organizations to present seminars or workshops:
  - Family law matters
  - Immigration
  - Estate planning
3. Offer to train church leaders at a Stake Bishopric Training Meeting, Stake Welfare Committee Meeting, or other church leadership training meeting
4. Organize chapter members to provide volunteer services at local legal aid Societies
  - Compile a list of legal aid organizations in your community for use by local priesthood & Relief Society leaders (can be found at [www.lawhelp.org](http://www.lawhelp.org))
5. Set a chapter goal to perform an appropriate number of volunteer hours by July 24, 2008
6. Raise funds for local pro bono service provider
7. Inform local ecclesiastical leaders of available resources through your chapter
8. Volunteer to speak to law students at a meeting organized by a student chapter
9. Sponsor regular pro bono service events (regular time, regular place) e.g. Lima, Peru
10. Establish a mentoring program for local law students
